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THOMAS MERRITT (1759-1842) (Volume 1)

1775-1836

Born at Bedford, N.Y. in 1759. Served in the Queen's Rangers, 1779-1783. Went to New Brunswick but returned to the United States at the peace. He came to Upper Canada in 1796. From 1803-1820 he was Sheriff of Niagara District. He died at St. Catherine's in 1842.

William Chace, a Rhode Island merchant had business interests in New York. His daughter, Penelope (1774-1845) married Dr. Jedediah Prendegast (1766-1848) who lived in Dutchess County, New York. The Prendegasts went to Upper Canada in 1808, settling at 12 Mile Creek. Finding it difficult to obtain payment of sums due for medical services and fearing war with the United States, Dr. Prendegast returned to New York in 1812, leaving the care of his lands and the collection of his debts to Thomas Merritt and his son, William Hamilton Merritt who was to marry Catherine Prendegast on 13 March, 1815. Thereafter the two families had continuous contacts and a good deal of Prendegast correspondence is found in the William Hamilton Merritt papers.

The greater part of the papers consists of Chace family correspondence on business and personal matters, 1782-1808. There are a few miscellaneous papers which include a purchase of land in Grantham by William Chace, 1844, and a memorandum as to the erection of a stone in memory of Dr. Jedediah and Penelope Prendegast, 1848.
