*Court of Escheats*

HALIFAX, 2d Jan. 1815.

ALL persons interested in the following LANDS, are desired to take Notice that Requests of Office will be taken before the Commissioner of Escheats and Forfeitures, at the Court House in Halifax, on the 7th day of June next, touching the performance of the Conditions, contained in the several Grants of said Lands from the Crown, which proceedings will be founded on Information to be filed by His Majesty's Attorney General by order of His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, for the purpose of reinvesting the Crown with the Possession of their Lands; that the same may be re-granted pursuant to his Majesty's Instructions, to persons who will improve and Cultivate the same, that is to say:

All the lots and parcels of Land, now lying in the Township of Preston, and contained in a Grant or Patent, dated the 15th October, 1784, whereby 32,000 acres of Land, then lying in the Township of Dartmouth, and County of Halifax, were Granted to Theophilus Chamberlain, Esq. and One Hundred and Sixty-three other persons; which lots and parcels of Land, under the authority of said Grant, were assigned and set off to the following persons, that is to say: The Lots or Divisions of Land, in said Township assigned to
