HALIFAX, 2d Jan. 1815.

A LL persons interested in the following LANDS, are desired to take Notice, That Quoxtalls of Office will be taken before the Commissioner of Escheats and Forfeitures, at the Court House in Halifax, on the 7th day of June next, touching the performance of the Conditions, contained in the several Grants of said Lands from the Crown, which proceedings will be founded on Information to be had by His Majesty's Attorney General by order of His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, for the purpose of re-investing the Crown with the possession of their Lands; that the same will be re-granted pursuant to his Majesty's Instructions, to persons who will Improve and Cultivate the same, that is to say:
