

## How To Use the Indexes to the Saunders Papers

*Loyalist Coll.* ✓ Finding aids to the Saunders Papers consist of a subject index, author index, chronological list and a shelf list. Documents are numbered sequentially according to volume and item number, eg. 1-234. This number appears only on the shelf list and on the document itself. The shelf list is arranged according to date so all other references must be converted to a date before the shelf list can be used.

All finding aids are in the card catalogue in the hallway, except the chronological list which is in the grey binder in the supervisor's room.

### Finding aids :

1. Subject Index : The Subject Index gives an arbitrary reference number which must be (1) converted to a date using the chronological list and then (2) translated to a document number using the shelf list.

2. Author Index : The Author Index refers to a date which in turn must be converted to a document number using the shelf list.

3. Chronological List : The chronological list is arranged by a reference number which is linked to a date. This date can then be converted to a document number using the shelf list. *This is included in this folder (See Inventory)* ←

The Saunders Papers are available on microfilm. The microfilmed version follows the sequence of the shelf list. The document numbers are not indicated on the microfilm version. In the future, the Saunders Papers will be remicrofilmed with the document numbers marked on them.

## SAUNDERS PAPERS

This Collection is an amalgam, mainly of personal letters and family documents, amassed by the Saunders family and its affiliates, of Virginia, London, and Fredericton. Although it spans the years 1777-1892, geographical and chronological concentration is heavy in only two areas and times, the Charlestown-Georgetown vicinity of South Carolina 1781, and Fredericton and its environs 1847.

The 1781 segment focuses sharply on the Revolutionary War as seen from the viewpoint of John Saunders I, sometime Commander of the Georgetown redoubt; and the 1847 period offers an insight into social life at Fredericton, as seen by resident John Saunders II and his immediate family.

To its bulk, these Saunders men, John I and John II, are the chief contributors; and a third major contributor is London resident James Chalmers, father-in-law of John Saunders I. Chalmers' association with New Brunswick is limited to his purchase of the Gilfred Studholme estate on the Kennebecasis and his failed attempt to become an absentee landlord, an attempt paralleled in the purchase by John Saunders I of The Barony tract in York County; and researchers may find an interesting comparison of these New Brunswick estates in the hands of men who had been plantation owners in pre-Revolutionary New England.

The attention of those interested in the history of Fredericton City in its mid Victorian period may be drawn to the Diary of John

Saunders II, 1870-77. Although information in most entries of this Diary is rather brief, its density, together with the frequent recurrence of persons' names and subjects, makes it, in the whole, a revealing document.

Like its companion work, the Index to the Winslow Papers, this offers the researcher a three-way approach to a rather large and heterogenous body of documents. Its three parts consist of

- (a) a conventional index of subject-matter—persons, places, events, and things significant within the historical period covered;
- (b) an index of authors—a one-card entry for each item in the collection, each entry bearing date, number, name of author and of addressee, and a summary of its content—and all arranged alphabetically by author; and
- \* (c) an inventory—a list of all documents in the Collection, each with its number, author, and date—and all arranged chronologically for the convenience of researchers wishing to see a particular subject within a particular time-period.
