Letterbook copies of correspondence of the Civil Secretary of the Governor (later Governor General) at Quebec addressed to the Chief Justice of Lower Canada, the Attorney General, the Sheriff of Quebec, the Chairman of the Board of Works at Three Rivers, the Advocate General, the Adjutant General of the Militia, the Police Magistrate of Montreal and a large number of private individuals in Quebec, Lower Canada and other British North American colonies. Most, but not all, of the volumes include an alphabetical index of correspondents at the beginning of each volume. The letters are entered chronologically. (Also available on microfilm reels C-922 to C-926).

Additional in-letters of the Civil Secretary are available in the Upper Canada Sundries (RG 5, A 1) and the Civil Secretary's Correspondence (RG 7, G 20). Other out-letters can be found in the Civil Secretary's Letterbooks (RG 7, G 17 C).

This inventory describes all volumes in this series. Microfilm reel numbers are provided in the accompanying shelf list.
