Court Orders

- Parish assessment rates [sums included], as per Overseers of the Poor.
- Sheriff's orders pass in March and October 1844 to draw interest.
- Treasurer to pay Charles Scribner as Constable.
- All outstanding debts from March 1845 bear interest from demand until paid.
- Mr. N. Butters, render his account at court next Session.
- Parish of Upham; further alteration of district divisions for convenience of Commissioners of Highways; John Sherwood's farm mentioned in description.
- Parish of Westfield Divided into 3 districts for convenience of Commissioner of Highways
 - 1. Southwest side of Narepis [Nerepis] River
 - 2. Northwest side of St. John River
 - 3. Southeast side of St. John River (including Kennebecassis [Kennebecasis] Island)
- Collector of the Poor rates; Sussex; has until October term to collect.
- Regulations respecting the Low Lands in Westfield; protective boundary or fence to prevent trespass of animals- houses, swine, cattle etc., over River Nerepis onto property of Robert F. Hazen, George Harding, Charles Doherty, James Brittain; Hog Reeve; put any trespassers in pound; Philip Nase mentioned in description of boundary.
- Norton; divided into 3 districts for convenience of commissioners of Highways
 - 1. Northwest of Kennebecasis River below James Crabb's land
 - 2. All other land Northwest of Kennebecassis [Kennebecasis]
 - 3. Southeast of Kennebecasis
- Clerk to transmit claims of Widows of Soldiers of the Revolutionary War and request sums due.
