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The Queen v. James Taylor

James Taylor	Defendant; selling spirituous liquor contrary to law; submits written confession; on 17 September 1849 for selling liquor contrary to the Act of Assembly; fined 40 shillings and £1 12 shillings 10 pence for the costs of prosecution or be committed 40 days
