Accounts, Maryland Loyalists; appointments for James Chalmers and John Saunders, also John MacKay and Levin Townsend, both captains in the Queen's Rangers; Saunders' memorial to the commissioners for inquiring into the losses and services of Loyalists; an account of the number of American Loyalists who received allowances and those who did not, 1797; Lt. Gen. Simcoe's appointments for the West Indies, which includes James Chalmers; York County Militia c.1812 (Saunders was the commander); an account of J.E. Woolford's service in the military and government, 1797-1860 (he had been a member of the 2nd Queen's Royal Regiment of Foot and later barrack-master at Saint John; prisoners located at Charlestown and Georgetown during the Southern Campaign; memorial on behalf of the officers of the Maryland Loyalists; list of names and ages of the personnel of Capt. Saunders' Mounted Rifle Volunteers; and an account of the experiences of Daniel Parent during the American Revolution
