- Meeting minutes of Trustees of St Andrews Church, 3 Aug 1842; re. finances
- Debts due pew rents, with names and amounts, 1842
- Report of the managers of St Andrews Church, 1843-43; re revenues and expenses

- Subscription list for defraying expenses and repair of the church, with names and amounts, c. 1845
- Assurance policies, 1849 – Montreal Fire, Life, and Inland Navigation Assurance Company; give description of the minister's cottage and out buildings
- Financial statement – executors of the codicil of the late William Nelson
- List of subscribers for the purpose of making repairs in the steeple and the purchase of a bell, with names and amounts, 1851
- Accounts 1852-53 with David Lockhart, and with A. Heron
- Subscriptions list for a soiree and for Sabbath School Books and magazines, with names and amounts, c. 1854 (p. 50)
- Subscription list for repairs to church due to damage by wind and thunder and lightning, with names and amounts, 1854
- Article of agreement between Thomas Edson of the town of Niagara, builder, and the church, for repairs, 1855
- Minutes of meetings - re. repairs to the church after hurricane; very detailed; also contains correspondence pertaining to the contractors, etc.
- Subscribers list – raise money to enable Clergy Reserve Commissioner to advance money for purchasing real estate for the benefit of the minister, with names and amounts, p. 60
- Receipts for per rentals, 1841-43, (p. 66)
- Estimate for construction of new roof, 1855 (p 68); also Account Book of repairs, with names and amounts, 1855; plus subscription for same
- Church accounts with Treasurer, 1857 (p 75)
- Pew rents 1856
- Accounts – church for repairs in account with Treasurer, 1857
- Receipts to 1861
